

1 Think you have Dyslexia?

1 Dyslexia or any other Disability/Medical Condition confirmed. (With evidence)

2 You have a Dyslexia Screening with a Student Advisor. If Dyslexia is indicated you will need to have a full assessment with an assessor who will provide a written report.

3 Once evidence is received, you will need to register with the Learning Support Team:

- For reasonable adjustments such as extra time in exams and stickers (this takes 6 weeks to action).
- To agree information to share with your faculty.
- To apply for DSA.

4 After around 3 weeks you should receive a permission letter to book a DSA Needs Assessment by your funding body.

8 Our Advisors can help you to:

- Order equipment
- Arrange IT training
- Arrange support e.g. tutoring or mentoring

7 Approximately 3 weeks later you should receive a DSA funding agreement letter. You will need to contact us to book an appointment. Please bring your letter with you.

6 The Assessment Centre sends your report to you, us and the funding body approximately 3/4 weeks after the assessment.

5 You attend DSA assessment to discuss support needs.
