

## Induction Key Points for Students.

1. The session will be run on two platforms, the Induction on My Webinar and the Programme Leader sessions on Teams
  - a. My Webinar sessions will connect through Chrome.
  - b. To connect to Teams meeting choose “Continue on this Browser”
2. Please use Google chrome as your internet browser as recommended by My Webinar
3. Mobile devices such as phones and tablets can be used, but for the best experience we recommend using either a laptop or PC, this includes Apple Macs/MacBooks. You can download Chrome from the Apple App Store.
4. Go to <https://www.ucfb.ac.uk/apply/enrolment/induction/> and follow the correct path depending on if you are a new student or returning student. Don't worry this very clear and easy to follow on the site.
5. As the sessions are being conducted remotely, you will not need to attend site; please ensure you have a reliable Wi-Fi connection or a direct connection over Ethernet cable, we advise against using mobile data as you may run out during the sessions.
6. A test session has been created in both My Webinar and Microsoft Teams so you can have a trail run at joining a meeting. These will both be open from 10am – 5pm on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> September. Upon successful joining of the meeting you will see a confirmation screen.
